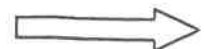

Sorry, we cannot accept the following items due to lack of storage space, child safety/health requirements, no access to recall notices, no testing equipment or lack of interest in old technology:

~This year we are no longer accepting posters, greeting cards, wrapping paper, bows, flower vases, briefcases, dolls or leftovers from yard sales.

~No electronics such as VCR/CD/DVD players, TV's, cordless phones, film cameras, computers/monitors, printers, keyboards

~No sports equipment including helmets, gloves, ice skates, racquets, bats, golf clubs, skis, etc.

~No holiday decorations (Xmas, Halloween, Easter, Valentines, New Years, Birthdays, Anniversaries etc.)

~No vinyl phonograph records, cassette tapes or VCR tapes

~No infant car seats, no strollers, no cribs, play yards or pack & plays (aka playpens)

~No clothing or footwear—we have no appropriate display racks.

~No used sheets, bed pillows, throw pillows, cushions or stuffed animals for sanitary reasons.

Kindly check with your local Public Works Department for proper disposal of white goods, tires, bicycles, large furniture, mattresses, scrap metal or hazardous waste.
